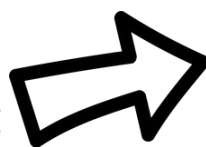

Service Advocate Updates

SERVICE ADVOCATES PROGRAM

The Service Advocates program offers Salve students the opportunity to participate in long-term civic engagement and service, providing them with the knowledge, skills, and experiences necessary to become active leaders.

Service Advocates complete 100 hours of service at an approved community partner site of their choice throughout the academic year (within both semesters) and receive a stipend of \$1,000 per year towards their education.

SCHOLARSHIPS DEADLINES FROM: SEPTEMBER 29th to NOVEMBER 30th, 2021

1) YDI Scholarship - \$2,222 - 1 Award (Deadline: September 29, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a resident of any of the 50 United States, District of Columbia or US Territories.
- B) Be 16 years of age or older and be enrolled in college or registered in a high school.

2) Cappex Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: September 30, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school sophomore, junior or senior.
- B) Be active in the community through volunteer or extracurricular activities.

3) Primus Scholarship - \$1,000 – 1 Award (Deadline: September 30, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a US citizen or legal permanent resident of the fifty United States or District of Columbia.
- B) Be currently attending (or planning to attend) a college located in the United States.

4) Olin E Teague Scholarship - \$4,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: October 15, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a senior year in an accredited U.S. high school with the intent of attending an accredited U.S. college or university in the fall.

B) Plan to pursue undergraduate or graduate studies in an aerospace field.

9) Accountability and Morality Scholarship - \$1,000 – 1 Award (Deadline: October 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a current high school senior, college student, or graduate student who is a legal resident of the US.
- B) Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher and be in good overall academic standing.

10) Encouraging Diversity Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: October 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher and be in good overall academic standing.
- B) Submit a 750-1,000 word essay response to the prompt: Why do you want to become a lawyer? What type of law are you pursuing? What motivates you?

11) Aspiring Attorney Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: October 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a current high school senior, college student or graduate student interested in studying law.
- B) Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher and be in good overall academic standing.

A) Be planning on studying any one of the following: Legal studies, Paralegal studies, Criminal Justice, Political Science, Criminology, Forensic Science, Doctor of Jurisprudence or any other undergraduate pre-law degrees.

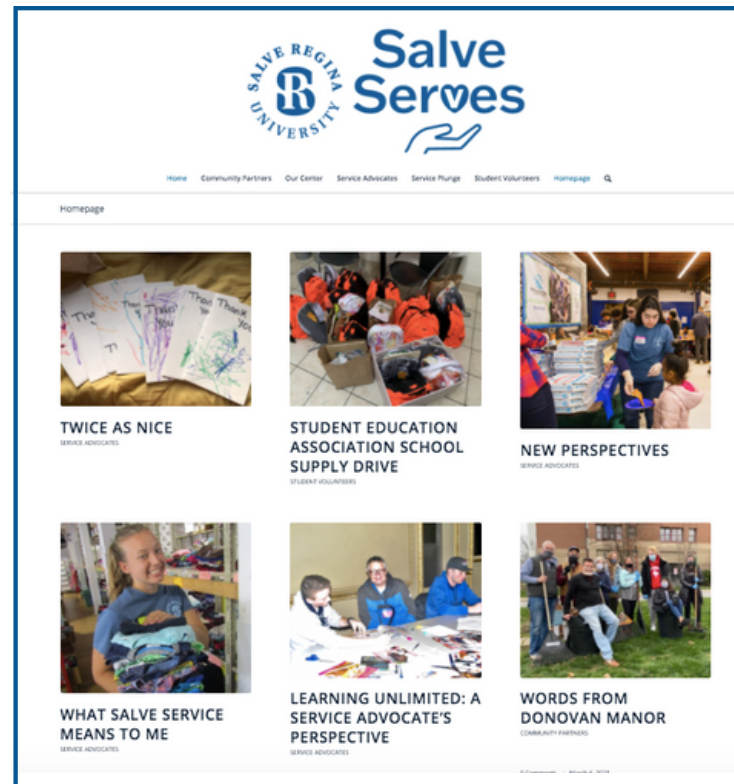
