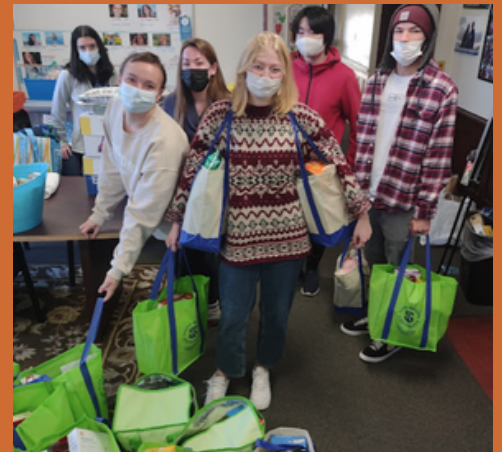

On November 12th, four Salve students traveled to the Edesia Factory in North Kingstown, RI. Edesia is a nonprofit social enterprise that manufactures and packages ready-to-eat, lifesaving foods for young children, schoolchildren, refugees, pregnant & lactating mothers, people living with HIV/AIDS, and other vulnerable populations suffering from malnutrition.

While visiting, Salve's volunteers were able to carefully sort through sachets of "Plumpy Nut" to verify any open packages (for traces of contamination) and also to ensure that quantities within each box were accurate with no errors resulting along the production line. In total, Salve helped to verify 50 boxes and sorted through over 7500 sachets. These volunteers were very thankful for the opportunity to have helped out at Edesia while simultaneously having assisted in making a difference in the lives of thousands of people in underdeveloped nations worldwide.

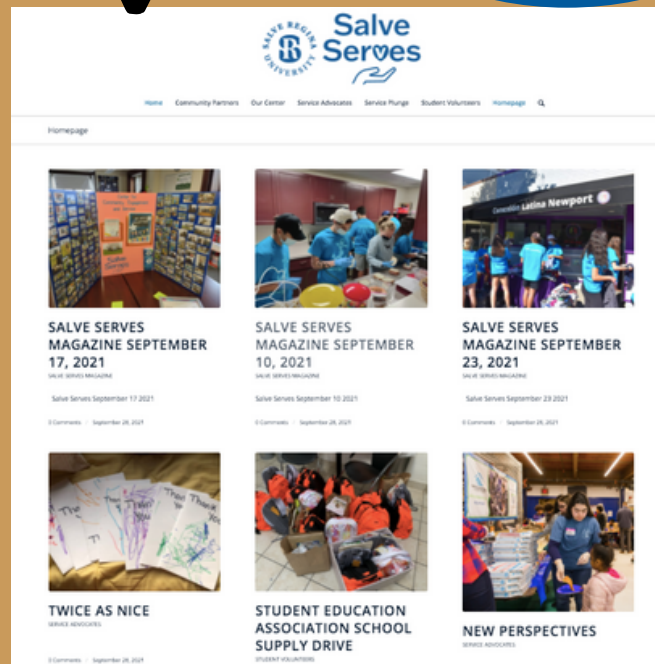

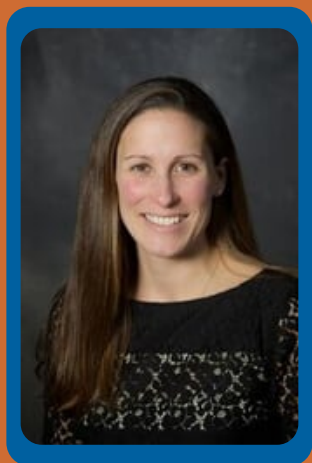
