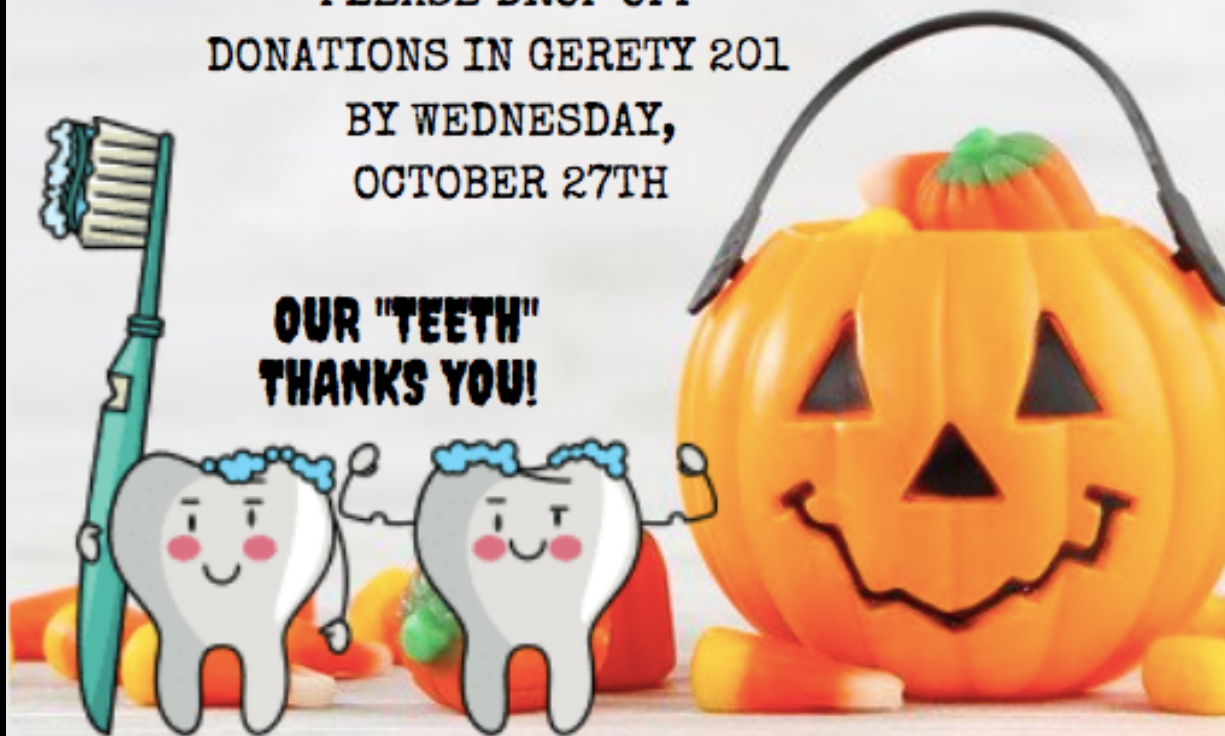

Salve's AmeriCorps Vistas run a two day per week After-School Program open to 5th and 6th graders at Thompson Middle School. The program allows Thompson students to be mentored by Salve students, engage in hands on S.T.E.M. learning projects such as through personal fruit and vegetable gardens, team building activities, and so much more. Ultimately this is accomplished through the utilization of the Center for Community Engagement and Service's office space where students gather to write in their journals and develop social skills for safe after school fun!



Athletic Service Opportunity

DO YOU LIKE BASKETBALL?

Volunteers are needed to assist with basketball drills and events with Newport Recreation. First sessions are starting on December 4th, 2021 and running through March of 2022.

The programs will run as follows:

- Fridays: 4pm-5pm at the Hut
 - starting January 7th, ending February 11th
 - K and Grade 1 Instructional Basketball
 - basic skills and drills, scrimmages
- Saturdays tentatively 8am-4pm
 - starting December 4th, ending March 5th
 - Grades 1-2 (co-ed) first group in the morning, boys grades 3 & 4, 5 & 6, 7 & 8 until midday, girls 3 & 4, 5 & 6, 7 & 8 in afternoon.
 - each grouping gets 1 hour
 - first 4 weeks of the program skill development drills, scrimmages for skills assessment
 - remaining weeks scheduled games

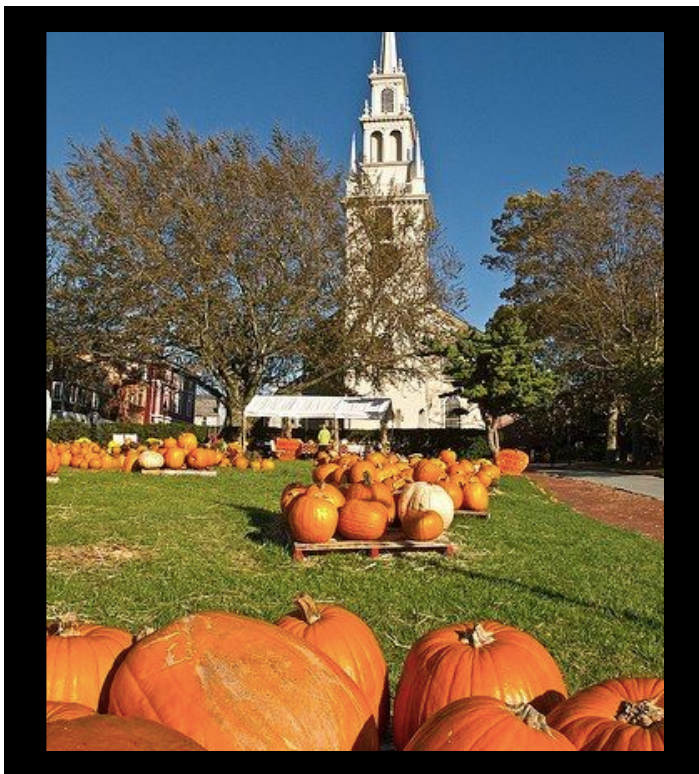

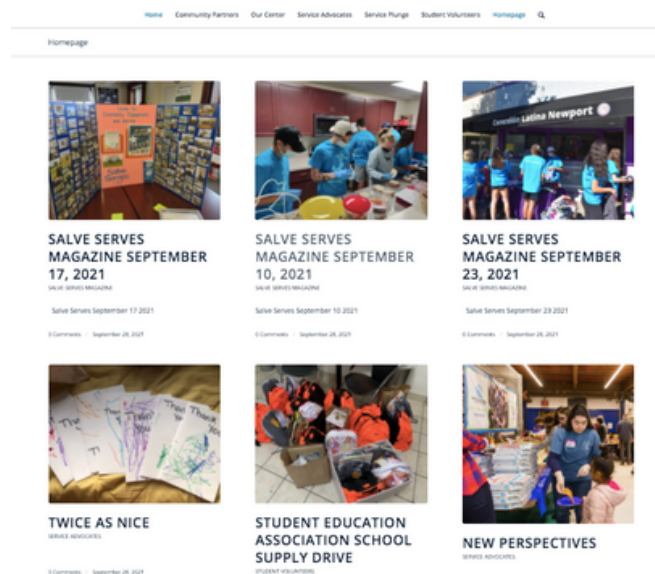
