Salve's AmeriCorps Vistas run a two day per week After-School Program open to 5th and 6th graders at Thompson Middle School. The program allows Thompson students to be mentored by Salve students, engage in hands on S.T.E.M. learning projects such as through personal fruit and vegetable gardens, team building activites, and so much more. Ultimately this is accomplished through the utilization of the Center for Community Engagement and Service's office space where students gather to write in their journals and develop social skills for safe after school fun!




Trinity Church Pumpkin Patch
